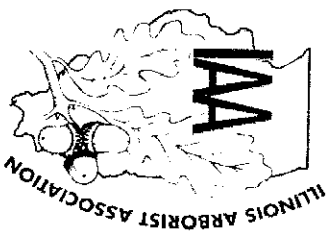

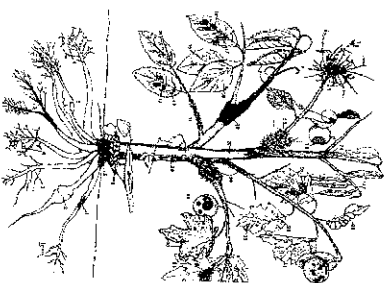

## Tree Diseases

August 21 & 28, 2010

Cost: \$150

**Tree Diseases:** This course will provide an in-depth study of many of the tree and shrub diseases found throughout Illinois and the Great Lakes region. The class will provide 10 hours of instruction. During this time attendees will learn: 1) basic tree disease concepts, 2) disease identification, life cycle and management, and 3) the plant diagnostic process. Students will learn to identify, understand and manage diseases from the following disease categories: bacteria, canker, needle, wood decay, foliar, root rot, vascular wilt and viral diseases. Material will be covered through PowerPoint slides, collected samples and outdoor plant walks and each student will receive a manual containing the material that will be covered. An online final exam will be given to test the student's comprehension of the subject matter.

**Location:** Lincoln Land Community College located at 5250 Shepherd Rd in Springfield, IL on Saturday, August 21st and Sunday, August 28th from 9:00am to 3:00pm. Classes will be held in the Millennium Center room 2204.

### Pest Diagnosis and Management (PDM)

Proposed Training modules and schedules for PDM domains provide additional training in diagnosis of plant problems, pest identification and plant health care management strategies. To receive credit for a domain, the student must complete 5 modules.

- Insect and Mite Pests-Required
- Tree Diseases-Required
- Abiotic Problems-Required
- Pesticide Safety and Application-Required
- Introduction to PHC/IPM-Elective
- Soils and Nutrient Management-Elective

To complete the Pest Diagnosis and Management Domains the student would need to successfully complete all four of the required modules plus one elective. Total instructional time would be approximately 50 hours or 10 hours per domain.
