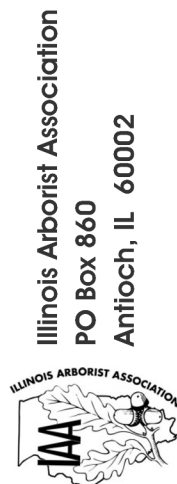

Course Highlights

This Advanced Training Course will focus on biotic and abiotic requirements of Illinois native trees, as well as some ornamental tree species. The course will be broken down into four sections, which will focus on light, moisture, soils and a field practical exam where we will test students using real-life examples of why or why not certain tree species should be planted in certain areas.

This class will provide information for all types of planting areas, not just parkways, in order to teach a broader perspective on tree species, environment and requirements. We will discuss the biological, evolutionary and chemical reasons why certain trees prefer certain conditions, where these certain areas are in Illinois and what "red flags" to look for when considering what tree to plant.

Our goal is to help educate municipal and commercial students on how to make a long-term and fiscally responsible investment in trees by choosing the right tree for the right place.
