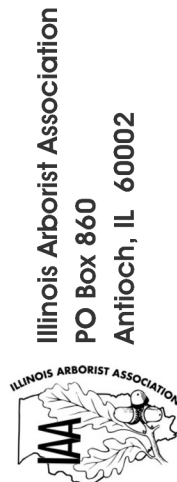
The Safety and Woods Worker Training Program provides professional and recreational sawyers with highly effective, hands-on training programs delivered by Certified Safety Trainers.
