## Course Highlights:

We will be meeting at a site that has multiple trees to be felled.

We will start by going over the Safety Features on the Chainsaw and the 4 Reactive Forces of a rotating chain, followed by the Six Step Precision Felling Plan.

The following will be demonstrated:

(1) Proper starting techniques; (2) Proper cutting stance and techniques; (3) Proper hand grip; (4) Bore/ plunge cutting; (5) Basic maintenance and hand sharpening.
