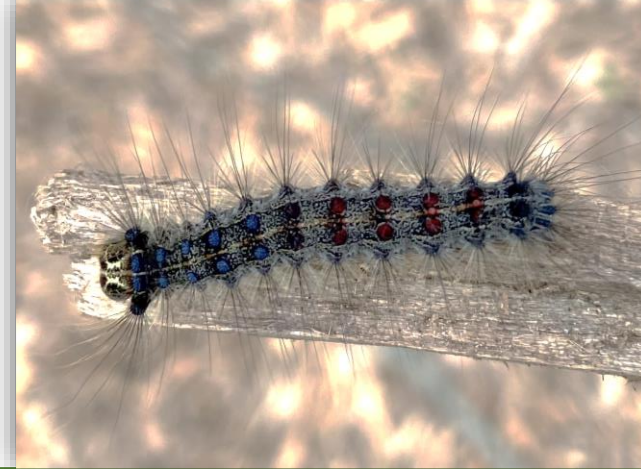






# Advanced Training:

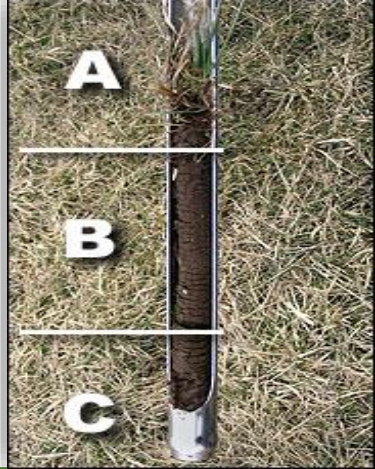

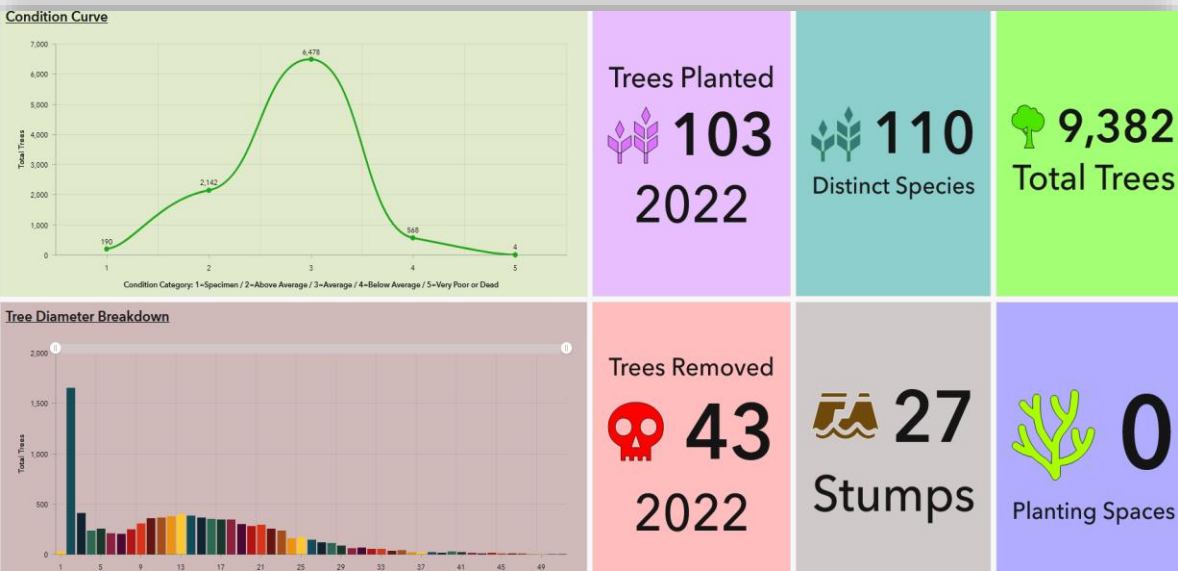

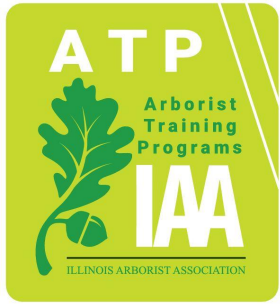
